ABOUT HUMPBACK WHALES

Megaptera novaeangliae

Humpbacks are a large baleen whale found throughout all of the world's oceans. They reach an average adult length of 12m (40ft) and may weigh up to 40,000 kg.

In the North Pacific, the population has made an impressive comeback in the past 50 years. Humpback whales were heavily targeted by commercial whaling in the North Pacific until 1967; by the end of this harvest, there may have been as few as 1,400 humpbacks left in this population. Following commercial whaling, estimates of humpback whales in the North Pacific grew to reach peak population levels in 2013 at 35,549 individuals. From 2014–2016, a marine heat wave in the Pacific likely resulted in a 20% decline in humpback whales (~7,000 whales). Since then, the North Pacific humpback whale population abundance has predicted to be steadily increasing by ~4% (Cheeseman et al., 2023, 2024).

The North Pacific population of humpback whales makes long-distance migrations. They range

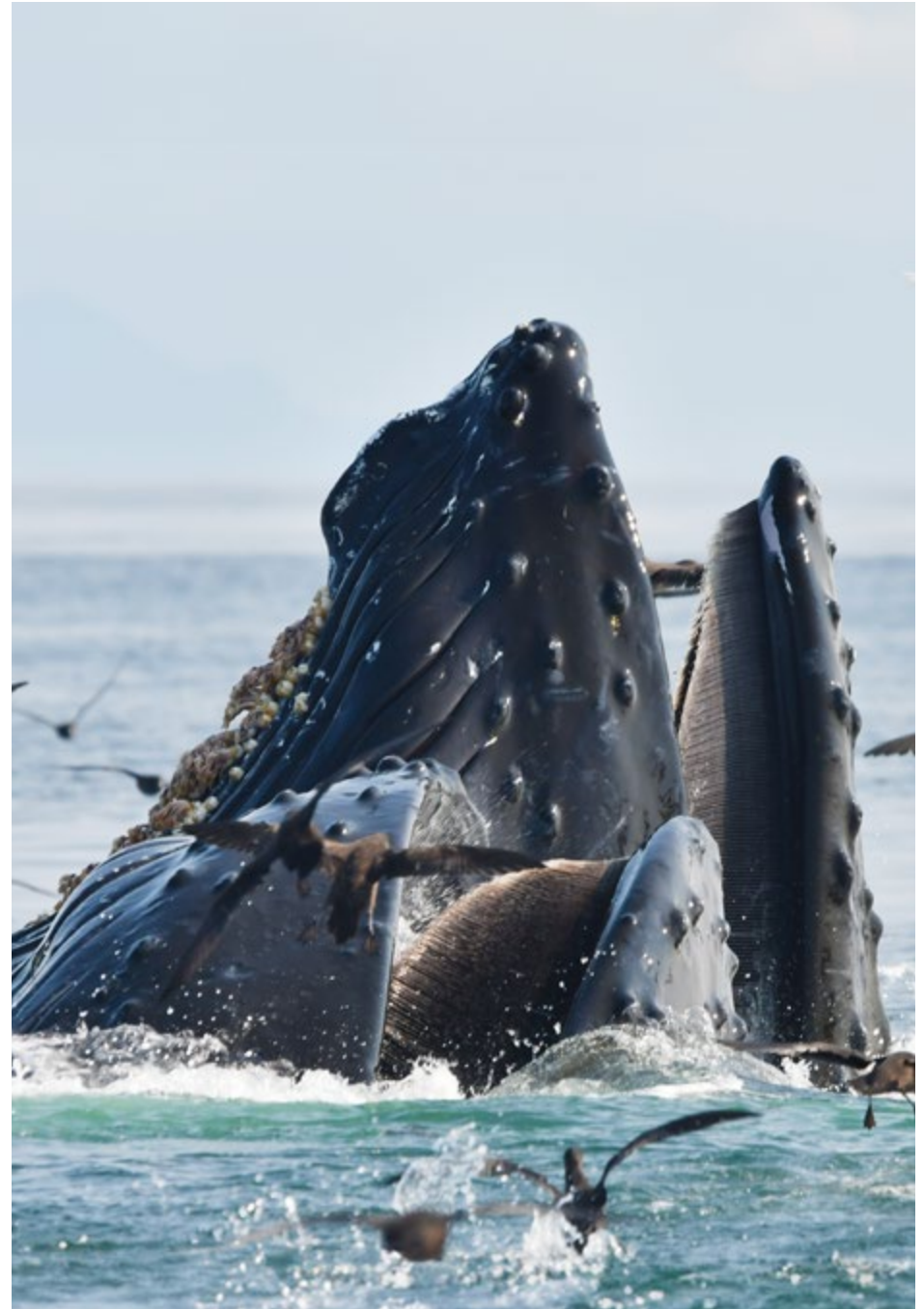
from winter breeding grounds in southern latitudes (Hawaii, Mexico, and southern Asia) to northern feeding areas (from California to Alaska and Russia) where they spend the summer months.

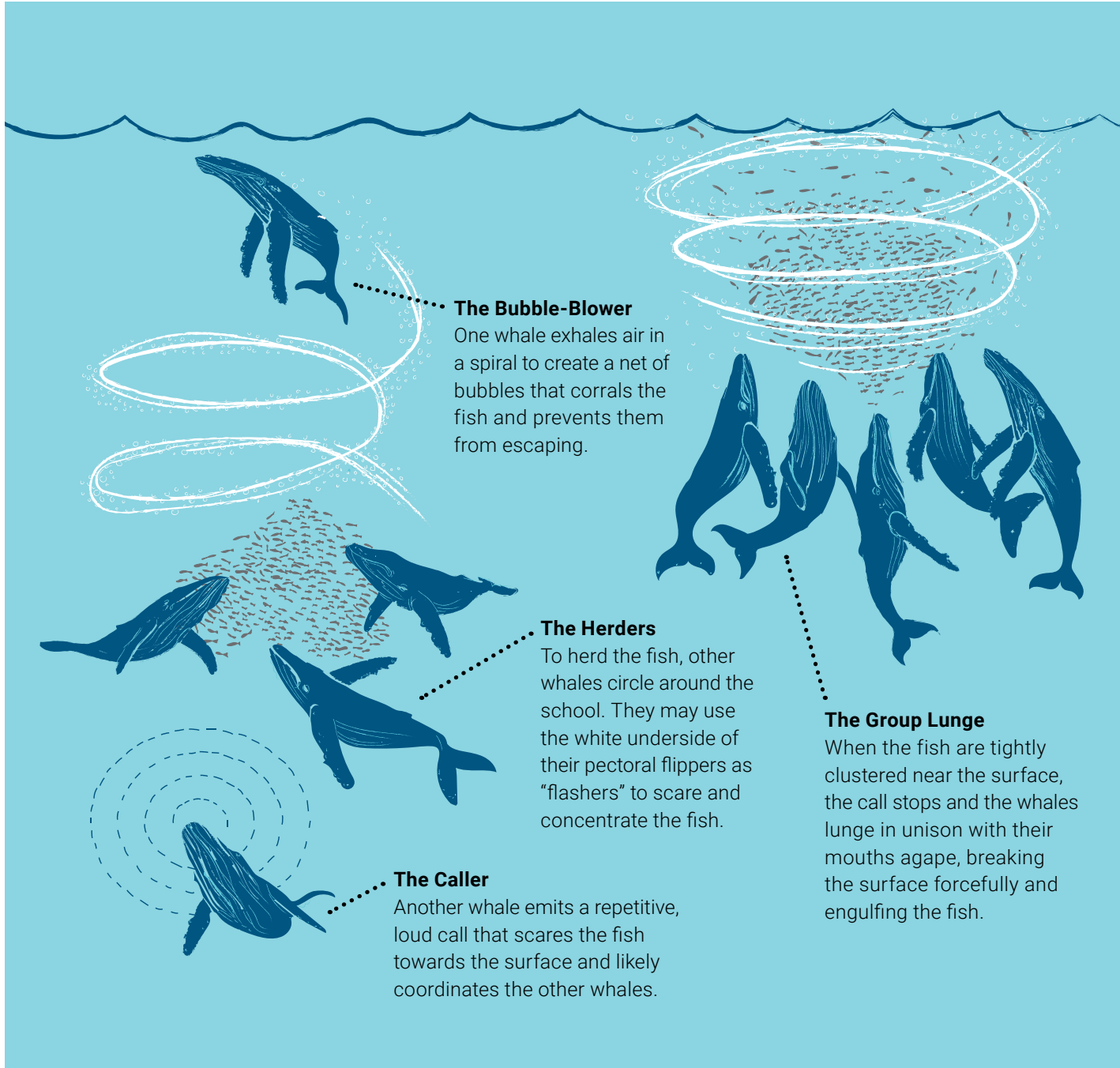
The waters humpbacks frequent in the summer months are rich in prey including krill and small schooling fish such as herring, capelin, sandlance, and pilchard.

Of all the baleen whales, humpbacks are most likely to engage in high energy surface behaviours such as breaching and slapping their tail flukes and pectoral fins. There is no definitive explanation for these behaviours; they likely have various meanings depending on the context.

In many parts of their range, humpbacks are greatly impacted by human activity. Entanglement, ship strikes, noise disturbance, and overfishing of prey impact these whales. Currently, humpback whales in British Columbia are listed as “Special Concern” under the Species at Risk Act.

The Bubble-Blower
One whale exhales air in a spiral to create a net of bubbles that corrals the fish and prevents them from escaping.

The Herders
To herd the fish, other whales circle around the school. They may use the white underside of their pectoral flippers as “flashers” to scare and concentrate the fish.

The Caller
Another whale emits a repetitive, loud call that scares the fish towards the surface and likely coordinates the other whales.

The Group Lunge
When the fish are tightly clustered near the surface, the call stops and the whales lunge in unison with their mouths agape, breaking the surface forcefully and engulfing the fish.

BUBBLE-NET FEEDING

Humpback whales are known as a rorqual whale, which means they have long pleats from their lower jaw to their abdomen that allows the throat to expand, engulfing huge amounts of food-filled water while feeding. Humpbacks then use baleen like a sieve to trap food while removing the salt water. Humpback whales employ several feeding techniques to obtain these mouthfuls; most spectacularly, bubble-netting, where one to several animals may create a circular wall of bubbles to concentrate food before lunging through it.

HUMPBACKS OF THE NORTH COAST

This catalogue includes whales primarily observed in Chatham Sound, Work Channel and Dixon Entrance East. Based on data collected from our citizen science project, the Ocean Wise Sightings Network (formerly B.C. Cetacean Sightings Network, wildwhales.org), humpback whales are the most commonly reported cetacean in this region. They are observed year-round in both winter and summer months. As of September 2023, this catalogue includes 434 whales documented in this study area.

WHALE SAFETY

For boater and whale safety, it is imperative that vessels operate carefully around humpbacks. Boaters have been severely injured by collisions with humpback whales in British Columbia. Boats should exercise caution in areas of known or potential humpback activity.

Humpbacks can surface suddenly and without warning. They often appear unaware of boat presence and boaters should not assume humpback whales know where the vessel is located. Humpback whales are known to rest at the surface, a behaviour known as logging, making them hard to see. Boaters should be on alert to humpback whale presence when transiting through coastal waters.



SIGNS THAT WHALES MAY BE NEARBY

- Bird activity
- Bait balls
- Blows (exhalations)
- Splashes
- Ecotourism vessels stopped or slowed





SLOW DOWN

If whale presence is detected or if you are operating in an area that is often used by humpbacks, slow down. Boaters in Chatham Sound should particularly pay attention around the mouth of Work Channel and through Edge Pass in the summer time and the entrance to the Prince Rupert harbour and through Brown Pass in the winter time. Both areas have a high degree of seasonal overlap between boats and whales.

DO NOT STOP IN THEIR TRAVEL PATH

If whales are bubble-net feeding, give them additional space as their surfacing can be abrupt and powerful. The whales may be very focused on feeding and oblivious to vessels in their vicinity.

GIVE WHALES SPACE

The federal Marine Mammal Regulations require that vessels keep a minimum of 100 metres away from most whales, dolphins, and porpoises, and keeping a minimum of 200 metres away if they are in resting position or with their calf – it's the law. Consider the whale's behaviour and size when assessing your approach.

PLEASE REPORT

Please report any incidents of disturbance, collision, or entanglement in fishing gear immediately to **DFO's Reporting Line 1-800-465-4336** or **Coast Guard VHF 16**. Never attempt to remove any gear off an entangled whale on your own. Specialized disentanglement teams are dispatched once reports are made.

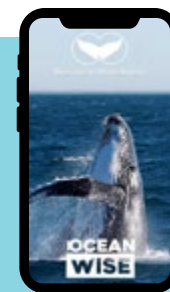
CANADIAN PACIFIC HUMPBACK COLLABORATION

The centralized database aids in understanding the whales' behavior, habitat use, population size, and the impact of threats such as vessel strikes and entanglement.
